The Isadora Duncan International Institute (IDII), founded in 1977 by Maria-Theresa Duncan—Isadora Duncan’s adopted daughter—and dance scholar Kay Bardsley, is a nonprofit arts and education organization devoted to preserving and evolving the legacy of the “Mother of Modern Dance.” Since 1987, the Institute has been based in the Hudson Valley at its Mother House, Tempio di danza, in High Falls, NY.

The IDII has performed and taught widely across the region, including appearances at the Byrdcliffe Theater, Bardavon Opera House, Kaatsbaan, Mills’ Mansion, Mohonk Mountain House, Bearsville Theater, the National Museum of Dance, The Egg, and Skidmore College in residency—as well as at many other schools, colleges, and cultural institutions throughout New York State. Further afield, *Jeanne Bresciani & The Isadora Duncan International Institute Dancer’s* stages have included Lincoln Center, The Joyce Theater, The British Museum, Peridance Capezio Theater, The Olympic Games, on Broadway and archaeological sites, palaces, stages, and institutes globally.
